Falls Creek Ranch (FCR) Lake Committee Purpose

A. Purpose(s):

- 1. Monitor and manage the health of Turner Reservoir (aka Falls Creek Ranch Lake).
- 2. Oversee recreational usage of the lake.

B. Principles:

- 1. Turner Reservoir is one of FCR's greatest scenic and recreational assets.
- 2. The health of Turner Reservoir is vital to the preservation of habitat for stocked fish and native wildlife, and to guarantee safe recreational opportunities for residents.
- 3. Turner Reservoir and its associated features (including, but not limited to, beaches and rafts) are on private property and are for the exclusive use of FCR residents and their guests.
- 4. FCR residents and their guests use Turner Reservoir at their own risk and agree to hold FCR harmless for any accident resulting from that use.

C. Lake Committee Chair(s) Responsibilities:

- 1. Lead the Lake Committee in the management of the committee responsibilities and Lake Rules.
- 2. Report to the Board as needed.
- 3. Report to FCR residents at Annual Meeting.
- 4. Manage the Lake Budget and prepare annual budget requests, or others as requested by the Board.
- 5. Recruit committee members.
- 6. Schedule and conduct periodic committee meetings and work days.
- 7. Assign committee members to specific responsibilities.
- 8. Recommend appropriate Lake Rules for Board approval.
- 9. Share responsibilities with co-chairs, if any; designate a representative in the absence of all co-chairs.
- 10. Communicate with the membership regarding Lake Rules and other issues that may arise concerning the lake.

D. Lake Committee Responsibilities:

- 1. Assess lake health (e.g., water level, the presence of algae, the survival of stocked fish) and take steps to reduce problems/improve health, as needed.
- 2. Assess stocked fish health and success, restock fish (carp and trout), and establish fishing guidelines, as needed.
- 3. Assess recreational lake usage and address needs, as able.
- 4. Maintain beaches, shared FCR watercraft, furniture, picnic tables, grill, and other equipment.
- 5. Develop Lake Rules, as needed.
- 6. Assist the committee chair(s) in duties, as requested.
